BASIC INCOME : THE PROPOSAL in a nutshell.

A basic income is a periodic cash payment unconditionally delivered to all on an individual basis, without means-test or work requirement.

Periodic: it is paid at regular intervals (for example every month), not as a one-off grant.

Cash payment: it is paid in an appropriate medium of exchange, allowing those who receive it to decide what they spend it on. It is not, therefore, paid either in kind (such as food or services) or in vouchers dedicated to a specific use.

Individual: it is paid on an individual basis—and not, for instance, to households.

Universal: it is paid to all, without means test.

Unconditional: it is paid without a requirement to work or to demonstrate willingness-to-work.

BASIC INCOME : MORE OR LESS WORK ?

MORE

- No more unemployment trap
- No more poverty trap
- More entrepreneurship

LESS

- Foster laziness
(« Should surfers be fed ? »)
- More taxes on other income (including wages and profits)

BASIC INCOME : IMPACT ON WAGES ?

INCREASE

- Higher negotiation power for workers
- Less incentives for taking low paid jobs
- More opportunities for education

DECREASE

- Wage as additionnal income
- More part-time jobs

TRANSFORMATIVE BECAUSE PARADOXICAL (not despite) ?

- In logic (Epaminondas' lie, Russel...), , epistemology (Hempel...) physics (Schrödinger's cat, EPR,...), economics (Easterlin...), etc., paradoxes are powerful triggers of innovation and change.
- Social systems are intrinsically paradoxical (G. Bateson, Y.Barel, A. Wilden, N. Luhmann)
- Paradoxes are linked to our current distinctions. We need new distinctions to observe and steer a changing world (generating new paradoxes).
